Kevin Clouse stated that the proposed amendments have been reviewed by the Walnut Township Zoning Commission; they approved with changes. The Regional Planning Commission (RPC) has reviewed and made substantial comments.

This list includes a highlight of the items that would be changed with Resolution 05-15

- RMU would add accessory buildings
- Dangerous wild animals would require 100 acres; this was approved by the Fairfield County Prosecuting Attorney
- Added a definition of moveable and permanent accessory structures
- RV's cannot be dwellings
- Permanent foundations are required
- Setback clarification roof overhang, not gutter
- Substantial Completion definition
- Value formula for damage or destruction of a property
- Definition of temporary structure
- Shed definition 2 smaller or 1 larger not to exceed 320 sq. ft. for conforming parcels
- I1 add retail use
- Create a Park District with overview of structures permitted, setback requirements, and minimum frontage
