Trustee Horn stated that he felt that the Village of Thurston would be more likely to agree to a merger if the merger with the Village of Millersport was completed now that an Agreement with the Village of Millersport would be taking place as noted in the Memorandum of Understanding with the Village of Thurston. Aaron Reedy from the Village of Thurston stated that the Memorandum of Understanding between Walnut Township and the Village of Thurston had not yet been signed and returned that there had not been any discussion between Thurston and the Trustees. He was disappointed that there had not been any joint meetings and therefore left in the dark.
